


## **Showcase Venue**

**Paid Parking:** The closest UWA Car-Park can be found along Gordon Street (Car Park 71) Please see next page for all parking options

**3 Hour Parking:** Council Parking is monitored by the City of Perth, directly outside the college at 2 Park Road Crawley - It is 3 hour parking from 8am to 6pm

Drop Off: Please note that if you are getting dropped off please use Park Road



For best parking we recommend parking in carpark 71. If this carpark becomes full, below are other alternatives. Please note that all carparks besides #71 require using the underpass beneath Stirling Hwy.
